LILLY ENDOWMENT COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP

The Carroll County Community Foundation is pleased to honor the recipient of the 2014 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship. Thanks to the generosity of Lilly Endowment, one Carroll County student will receive full-tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and equipment for four years of undergraduate study at any Indiana public or private college or university. The 2014 recipient is **Bryer Houston**.

Bryer, son of Jarett and Jennifer Houston, is a recent graduate of Delphi Community High School, where he participated on the varsity football, track and wrestling teams. Bryer was president of the National Honor Society and an elder for the Students for Progress. His other activities included the school newspaper, S.A.D.D., HOBY Indiana, Every 15 Minutes and Varsity D. Bryer's volunteer activities include the church clothes closet, Christmas baskets and bikes, senior lunches, cleaning community churches and Toys for Tots.

His awards and honors include 2013 Colts Academic All-State, 2013 Football Academic All-State, 2013 Wrestling Academic All-State, English Bradshaw Award, All-Hoosier Conference Football and IASP Academic All-Stars Football.

He plans to attend Purdue University to study engineering.

This is the seventeenth year that the Endowment has funded the Lilly Endowment Community Scholars program for outstanding students in Indiana. The Community Foundation defined the criteria based on the Endowment's stated goal to "raise the level of educational attainment in Indiana." The criteria used in the selection process included: scholastic achievements, financial need, communication skills, essay, interview and character.

There were 16 qualified and eligible Carroll County students who applied for the scholarship. A committee of volunteers evaluated the applications and selected the finalists who were interviewed by the Carroll County Community Foundation Board. The Carroll County Community Foundation has awarded 18 scholarships and renewals from 11 funds with an approximate value of \$64,500 in scholarships for the 2014-15 school year, including the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship.
