Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship

The Carroll County Community Foundation is pleased to honor the recipient of the 2015 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship. Thanks to the generosity of Lilly Endowment, one Carroll County student will receive full-tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and equipment for four years of undergraduate study at any Indiana public or private nonprofit college or university. The 2015 recipient is **Angela Musall**.

Angela, daughter of Brian and Jamie Musall, is a Twin Lakes High School graduate. She participated in a variety of activities that include HOSA, French Club, Freshman Mentoring, Art Club, tutoring, American Legion Poppy Days and the theatre's makeup crew. Angela was selected as a delegate to Hoosier Girls State. In addition to serving the elderly through Key Club, her service projects include the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, UNICEF and the American Legion. Through a class project, she became involved with the Wounded Warrior Amputee Softball Team and interviewed a wounded veteran and the Global Project Chair of Ossur Prosthetics in Iceland.

Angela is a 10-year member of 4-H and has earned several awards, including grand champion and overall grand champion honors. Other awards and honors include the softball Sportsmanship Award and Academic Excellence. She plans to attend Purdue University to study biomedical engineering.

For 18 years Lilly Endowment has funded the Community Scholars program for outstanding students in Indiana. The Community Foundation defined the criteria based on the Endowment's stated goal to "raise the level of educational attainment in Indiana." The criteria used in the selection process included: scholastic achievements, financial need, activities in and out of school, essay, interview and character.

There were 20 qualified and eligible Carroll County students who applied for the scholarship. A committee of volunteers evaluated the applications and selected the finalists who were interviewed by the Carroll County Community Foundation Board. The Carroll County Community Foundation has awarded 19 scholarships and renewals from 12 funds with an approximate value of \$74,380 in scholarships for the 2015-16 school year, including the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship.

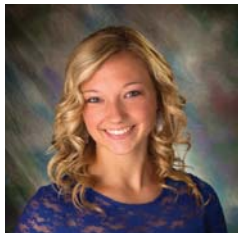

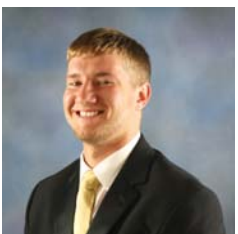
Wyatt Rumell
