Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship

The Carroll County Community Foundation is pleased to honor the recipient of the 2016 Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship. Thanks to the generosity of Lilly Endowment, one Carroll County student will receive full-tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and equipment for four years of undergraduate study at any Indiana public or private nonprofit college or university. The 2016 recipient is **Alexa Metzger**.

Alexa, daughter of Chris and Roxanna Metzger, is a Carroll High School graduate. She participated in a variety of activities that include National Honor Society, Key Club and Brady's Hope. As a Cougar Paws Mentor, she was matched with an elementary student for a weekly mentoring session. Alexa also volunteered with Teen Serve during the summer. At her church, she is a member of the worship band and the youth group. Alexa has volunteered with a local vacation bible school and a mission vacation bible school in Kentucky.

She is a three-year member of the Tennis Team. Alexa's academic honors include Carroll High School Top Scholar, Rotary Club Citizenship Award and an achievement recognition for completing a school triathlon.

Alexa plans to attend Purdue University to study nursing.

For 18 years Lilly Endowment has funded the Community Scholars program for outstanding students in Indiana. The Community Foundation defined the criteria based on the Endowment's stated goal to "raise the level of educational attainment in Indiana." The criteria used in the selection process included: scholastic achievements, financial need, activities in and out of school, essay, interview and character.

There were 10 qualified and eligible Carroll County students who applied for the scholarship. A committee of volunteers evaluated the applications and selected the finalists who were interviewed by the Carroll County Community Foundation Board. The Carroll County Community Foundation has awarded 23 scholarships and renewals from 14 funds with an approximate value of \$77,400 in scholarships for the 2016-17 school year, including the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship.

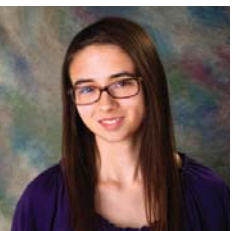
