You may begin, save and return to your application at any time. **All sections, including requests for recommendations, must be completed in order for you to finalize and submit your application. In order to be considered, scholarship applications must be complete and submitted by August 29, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.**

The 2017 Carroll County Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Program

One Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship will be awarded to a Carroll County resident. Deadline: August 29, 2016.

Purpose: The purpose of the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship Program is to help raise the level of educational attainment in Indiana and to leverage further the ability of Indiana's community foundations to enhance the quality of life of the state's residents.

Scholarships: The program will provide scholarships for otherwise unreimbursed full tuition, required fees, and a special allocation of up to \$900 per year for required books and required equipment for four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis, leading to a baccalaureate degree at any Indiana public or private nonprofit college or university accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

THE COMMITTEE WILL ONLY CONSIDER COMPLETED APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED BY August 29, 2016.

Key Elements:

- The program is open to all Carroll County residents who graduate from an accredited Indiana High School by 2017 and receive their diploma no later than June 30, 2017, (a high school is considered accredited for purposes of the program if it is accredited by the State Board of Education or by a national or regional accreditation agency that is recognized by the State Board of Education); and who intend to pursue a full-time baccalaureate course of study at an accredited public or private nonprofit college or university in Indiana.

Scholarship Recipient is to be known as a Lilly Endowment Community Scholar.

Lilly Endowment requires that the following statements be agreed to by an applicant and/or recipient and included on the student application, as well as in a scholarship acceptance letter to be signed by each selected scholar:

- "If I receive this scholarship, it is my intent to pursue four years of undergraduate study on a full-time basis leading to a baccalaureate degree at an Indiana college."
- "I understand that the total maximum amount of my scholarship is calculated on the basis of my chosen college's tuition and required fees beginning with the 2017-18 school year."
- "To assist with the processing of scholarship payments each semester or quarter and to avoid late fees, I will forward to the Carroll County Community Foundation immediately upon receipt all invoices for tuition and any eligible fees that may be covered by my scholarship."
- "I will account for the amount of the special allocation spent for required books and required equipment with official receipts and other documentation. I will return to Independent Colleges of Indiana any amount of the special allocation remaining at the end of each school year."
- "I agree to notify Independent Colleges of Indiana of any scholarship awards I may receive for tuition or required fees from a source other than the Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship."
- "I will keep the Carroll County Community Foundation apprised annually by June 1 of my enrollment and academic status during college, by completing and returning any surveys or forms as may be provided by the Community Foundation."
- "Upon graduation, I will keep the Carroll County Community Foundation apprised annually by June 1 of his or her education and/or employment status for at least ten years after graduation, by completing and returning an alumni survey or other forms as provided by the Community Foundation."

Criteria for the Scholarship:

Academic Performance: (20%) Grade point average/class rank; SAT/ACT or PSAT scores; must be in the top 1/3 of class;

Community/School/Work Experience: (20%);

Financial Need (20%) will be a factor in making this award. Students must complete the financial profile section in the application;

Essay: (10%) 500 hundred word essay;

Good Character: (10%) Student has not been convicted of a crime or placed on probation. Student has solid recommendations from people from whom they are not related;

If chosen as a finalist, the applicant agrees to participate in an interview (20%).

The scholarship recipient must give permission to use any general, non-financial information included in this application for publicity purposes.

- On-line application must be received by **August 29, 2016**, with uploaded transcript completed by guidance counselor/director and letters of recommendation.
